GENERAL INFORMATION

Tournament Format

Classic 3 Event & Barefoot tournament for able-bodied.

Best of 2 rounds of each event for Canadian Championship medals.

ELIGIBILITY

Competitors must hold a WSWC competitive license, be properly registered, meet qualification standards, and be either a Canadian Citizen or a landed immigrant in Canada (WSWC Rule Book Appendix III, (1) and Appendix VI) at time of registration.

DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF QUALIFICATIONS

All qualifications must be received by WSWC national office by 4pm EST Monday, August 6, 2012. Rule Appendix III, 1.2).

Registered competitors that fail to meet eligibility requirements prior to the deadline will have their registration fee refunded in full.

REGISTRATION

Online up to midnight EST, August 10, 2012.

Full payment must be made with registration. Registration on or after August 10 must be done at check-in on-site, with an extra \$75 late entry service charge as per Appendix III, section 1.5 of the WSWC rule book.

Various fundraising activities will take place during the week. Live & silent auctions, 50/50 draws and more. A silent auction will be held all day, Thursday August 16, 2012.













WOMEN SLALOM OPEN EVENT:

Top 1 skier

NOTE: If there is a skier or jumper in the top shown above, in the Open Event, but already has qualified through the World Ranking List criteria, the opportunity to enter the Pro Event will move to the next best placed Open Event skier or jumper.

TENTATIVE TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE (subject to change)

IMPORTANT NOTE: If we get <u>more</u> than 140 skiers registered for the Classic 3 event water ski Nationals, which we expect we may, this proposed schedule will have to be re-done. Changes may include: add on a day earlier to the Nats schedule, <u>or</u> all slalom rounds will then ski one round on lake 1 and the other round on lake 2. Details will be forwarded if these changes are made. Please make your travel plans knowing the Nationals may start on Sunday.
